



### Maths

In our maths lessons this term, we will begin by understanding the values of each digit when they are in different columns. We will look at 3 digit numbers and 4 digit numbers. We will be able to read and interpret number lines marked in multiples of 1s, 10s, 100s, 1000s and round numbers to the nearest 100 or 1000. Year Fours will progress to negative numbers and how we can count backwards when using them. After focusing on place value, we will begin looking at addition and subtraction. We will focus on counting on a number line first, then progress to using part whole models and column methods.

We will also continue with our big push on times-tables, as these form an important basis for many areas of the maths curriculum. Please encourage your child to access TT Rockstars as often as possible to support them with this essential knowledge. Usernames for TT Rockstars can be found in the children's Partnership books.
