Dear Parents/Carers,

We are currently creating a list of pupils whose parents may be classed as key workers. We are still awaiting clarity from the government and will be in a position to confirm our provision offer as soon as possible. As soon as we know, we will let you know.

We will be open for those children whose parents are confirmed key workers as well as those children who may be vulnerable during such a closure.

We will contact you directly if your child falls into this category and clarify our provision offer e.g. time of opening, lunch arrangements etc.

School however will be fully closed on Monday 23rd March, Tuesday 24th March and Wednesday 25th March to undertake a specific deeper clean of the whole school in readiness for re-opening on Thursday 26th March.

The weekend will allow surfaces to become dormant of any possible contaminants facilitating the focussed clean starting on Monday. We are still able to say at the time of writing that there have been **NO** cases of Coronavirus confirmed in any of our pupils or staff and that this is a precautionary measure only.

We will be providing a further update today with reference to home learning and homework packs, which staff have been working so hard to produce, and include details of collection if your child is currently absent.
