Staffing News

We are really sad to see her go, but we will see her again in her new capacity when she comes to support her replacement and check on how well we are doing with our finances.

We are currently recruiting for a new School Office & Business Manager and Miss Stirrett will be with us until this process is complete. I would like to personally thank her for the enormous support she has given to the Academy and also to me during my first year in post.

Office Hours

Just to remind you that office hours are from 8:30am to 4:30pm and the phone lines are operated from 8:00am to 4:30pm Monday to Thursday and 8:00am to 4:00pm on a Friday. Thank you for your patience and support in this matter.

Breakfast Club

We are changing our breakfast club provision and will soon be offering the club out to all pupils from EYFS (F2) to Y6 to attend the club. The club will have additional staffing and children, including younger children, will attend without parents/carers. Club registration will be essential and there will be a booking process to ensure all children are safeguarded. More information to follow soon.

Gates

The car entry/exit gates must not be used by pedestrians or children, on foot, scooter or bicycle. This is for very obvious safety reasons, as staff, deliveries and school visitors arrive by car through these gates. Breakfast club should only be

accessed by the pedestrian gate on Manor Farm Lane. In addition, it is important that the school driveways are not used to park at drop off and collection times, these entrances and exits as stated above are used throughout the day, but more importantly you may prevent emergency vehicles entering the school.

SNAG Group

We have a democratically elected pupil group called SNAG - School Nutrition Action Group, who have been working hard with Mrs Kay on improving healthy eating at the Academy. The SNAG group are now reviewing and re-organising our provision of the KS2 tuck shop. They themselves will write to you soon, with the new policy on school tuck.

On Tuesday 4th February, Hands On Science will be visiting The Glapton Academy to deliver two engaging and 'Hands On' workshops for Year 2. The workshops will enable the children to apply and further develop the knowledge they have gained as part of our Magnificent Materials topic and will offer plenty of opportunities to learn through discovery!
