To Reduce Risk Clean School Uniform Every Day



Please ensure your child comes in freshly clean uniform every day.

School uniform is required as it can be washed and dried easily over night.

We have lots of 'New to You' Uniform available in school.

Please let Mrs Lang know if you require uniform

To reduce risk Please ONLY bring in...

- ✓ Water bottle with your child's name clearly labelled.
- ✓ Coat only if needed.





Please do not bring in

- XAny bags or pencil cases.
- XAny equipment (we will supply everything your child needs).
- XPartnership Books.
- XFood or snacks

If it looks like it will be sunny...

- ✓Please ensure your child has once a day sun cream on before the school day starts. We cannot put this on for your child.
- ✓ Ensure your child has a sun hat.
- ✓ Remember the water bottle.









To reduce risk

When coming to the school...

Please do NOT

- XTouch any doors, gates or items around the entrances.
- XStand around in groups.
- XGather at your designated gates.
- XEnter the site at any time without an appointment (Appointments for exceptional circumstances only).


Next is what we need you to do...





To reduce risk When coming to the school

- ✓ Only arrive during the allocated time provided to you.
- ✓ Space yourselves out at least 2m from other families.
- ✓ Only 1 adult to accompany the child(ren).
- ✓ Very quickly drop off to the receiving teacher.





To reduce risk When coming to the school

- ✓ No conversations with staff.
- ✓ Phone the office with any queries or concerns.
- ✓ Use the specified exit gate to receive your child.
- √Y6 may arrive to and depart from their gates on their own.
- ✓ Be aware of the latest guidelines for travelling safely:



possible. «






To reduce risk In classrooms...


- √ There is a separate first aid kit for each Bubble.
- ✓PPE is available to staff who need to give first aid.



✓ Your child will only learn and play with the children in their Bubble - this will reduce the risk.









To reduce risk In classrooms...

- √ Tables are as far apart as possible preferably 2m+ apart.
- ✓ Children will be given their own equipment and packs to use.
- ✓ There will be a maximum of 15 children in a room.







To reduce risk At lunchtimes...

Food



- ✓ Your child will have their food delivered to their classroom.
- ✓ The same member of staff will aim to do this daily.
- ✓ Lunches will be eaten in the classrooms at tables or outside in a set play zone
- √The classroom will be cleaned and disinfected while the children play




To reduce risk At lunchtimes...



Play

- ✓ The group of up to 15 will have their own separate play space.
- √ They will not be mixing with others in different groups.
- ✓ They will be allocated the same adults at lunchtimes where possible.



To reduce risk Also...

We will ensure that all adults and children:

✓ frequently wash their hands with soap and water for 20 seconds and dry thoroughly.



- ✓ clean their hands on arrival at the setting, before and after eating, and after sneezing or coughing.
- ✓are encouraged not to touch their mouth, eyes and nose.
- ✓ use a tissue or elbow to cough or sneeze and use bins for tissue waste ('catch it, bin it, kill it').

To reduce risk

If someone is showing symptoms of COVID-19



- ✓ We have a separate room for isolation within each building.
- ✓ We will call all listed adults until contact is made please ensure your phone number is up to date and available.
- ✓ We will use PPE if we need to be within 2m to help your child.
- ✓ There will be separate toilet facilities for a child who is showing symptoms.

At the current time...



On Fridays we are closed to all pupils, except:

√ Vulnerable and key worker children



This is to ensure:

- ✓ Extra cleaning
- √ Teachers develop home learning for the next week
- ✓ Staff training and PPA can take place
