The UK will now begin an official period of mourning for 10 days, until Her Majesty's funeral. We will send further details to you about this period and how the school will be responding to it. The DFE have indicated that schools in England will remain open. We will of course be adjusting our plans to provide time to reflect and consider this significant, historic and sad period of time.

From Monday, a book of condolence will be available in reception. All staff and parents who wish to pass on their condolences to the Royal Family are welcome to visit to sign the book. You may also sign the online book of condolence at <u>www.royal.uk</u>

This sad news will affect adults and children in many different ways. If we require any support for our children Mrs Oliver has access to bereavement resources and if any children need to reflect and grieve, trained staff will be available to provide support and answer any questions they may have.

Rev'd Lydia has let us know that today Holy Trinity with St Francis and St Mary's Churches will be open from 12-1pm where there will be an opportunity to light a candle, sign a book of condolence and leave a floral tribute if anyone should wish. A single bell will toll throughout the hour - if you are close to one of the churches, you may hear it - it marks the start of a period of national mourning.
